New software: lower cost for future programming

Each 4100ESi panel can store multiple system programs in the monitored 2GB Compact Flash memory, from the time of initial startup right through to the present. This mass storage device is intended to ensure that a system's critical revision history is not lost and always stays in your possession.

And this can all be done with the ability to switch back and forth between programs. While one program is live, another program can be built and downloaded to a stand-alone panel or multiple network nodes, without impacting network performance.

These important features can save you money on servicing; now any trained service company can be called in to make software changes. If you change service companies, your new provider can easily access the installed software to make any required changes. No need for pass-codes, or to recover the software database from your old service company. As an extra safeguard, your trained service providers can supply backup copies of any changes to Tyco Fire Protection Products for safekeeping.

Faster on-site and off-site diagnostics for higher survivability, lower servicing costs

The 4100ESi platform has new diagnostic tools to provide operator fault search facilities allowing cabling faults to be quickly identified and potentially saving labour costs. This can be accessed from anywhere; at the panel, an operator workstation, or a remote laptop. It also has the ability to upload TrueAlarm service reports. These reports can identify problem areas so they can be rectified before they result in costly call-out fees. Reports can also be used for compliance testing to identify the detectors tested and report on the sensitivities of each sensor installed. This saves your service company time and helps to reduce labour costs. Another great feature of the 4100ESi platform is the optional internet interface (or SafeLINC card). This allows your upgraded 4100ESi panel to send an email to assigned staff or your service company notifying them of alarms, faults or other events. With the appropriate equipment and assistance from your IT department, your service company can then interrogate the panel from their office to determine the appropriate spare parts for repair, helping to reduce downtime and labour costs.

More device choices

With the 4100ESi system, you can upgrade to intelligent new Gen6 *MX* devices while preserving your investment in IDNet and MAPNET devices. You can build out your MAPNET and IDNet cards or expand to *MX* devices, which feature lower power consumption, higher point capacity, multifunction capabilities and enhanced diagnostics to isolate device-level wiring faults.
